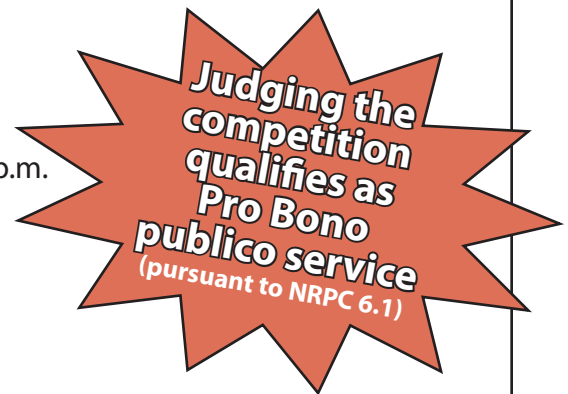

## **3rd Annual In-House Negotiation Competition**

**T**he Third Annual In-House Negotiation Competition, sponsored by the New Lawyers Committee of the Clark County Bar Association and the Saltman Center for Conflict Resolution, will take place at the William S. Boyd School of Law on Friday evening, March 12, 2010.

Student teams will be negotiating three scenarios in the family law area. Judges will move between teams, evaluating their negotiating skills and awarding them points. At the end of the competition, while scores are being tallied, judges will be asked for feedback on how teams performed and what techniques could be improved. Winners of the competition will be asked to join the Society of Advocates and will represent the Boyd School of Law at the ABA's next regional Negotiation Competition in November 2010.
